Excluding General Rules 5.0 Scale Aerobatic Sound Limits, 5.1 Maximum sound levels, 5.2 Standard Method of Sound Measurement, 5.3 Ground Sound Level Test. Time Limits 13.1, 13.2, 13.3 and 13.4

NOTE: We will utilize 5.4 In-Flight Judging Criteria, Known and Unknown Sequences, which is implemented by the judges. Judges will issue a 0, 5, or 10 for sound at the end of each sequence. Too Noisy - 0, Acceptable - 5, Very Quiet - 10. and Time Limits: 13.5 The use of legal positioning maneuvers before entering and after exiting the aerobatic airspace.
